# OLD BUSINESS

## a. Alaina Robarge Conservation District Educator Update

Alaina reported that she attended the Stormwater training in Syracuse and found it helpful.

She presented the Watershed Model to third graders at Bloomfield Elementary School last week, and she will be presenting it at Marcus Whitman on Thursday.

Alaina reported that she has been working on the pet waste rack card. She shared her current copy and asked for comments, there were none.

Motion to approve ordering 1,000 rack cards printed on recycled paper, and 8 clear plastic brochure holders for \$243 (to come out of the 2019 budget) from VistaPrint.

Alaina explained that the dog bone pet waste bag dispensers that were originally delivered were unacceptable. The paint used to put the logo on the dog bone did not adhere and was easily scraped off. The company reprinted the order for no additional cost. The reprinted dog bones have been distributed to each municipality. It was decided that the scraped ones would be distributed to each County's humane society and anywhere else that they can be distributed.

Lastly, Alaina reported that she has been informed that the Ontario Public Library in the Town of Ontario would like to host a rain barrel workshop in 2020. The Coalition agreed that this would be a good location for the 2020 Wayne County rain barrel workshop. Ontario County will need to pick a location.

## b. <u>Luke Scannell DEC Update</u>

Luke reported that there are no new developments with the permit. He also reported that the Albany office has an employee on medical leave and that this is causing delays in some permitting. If you have an issue, please reach out to Luke and he will try to assist.

#### c. Kim Boyd BME Update

Kim reported that she reached out to the Town of Geneva but they are not interested in joining the Coalition at this time.

She reported that she also attended the Stormwater Conference in Syracuse and she shared some helpful information. Kim felt that concerns were heard and changes will be made including relaxing some requirements on outfall inspections and catch basin cleanings. Municipalities will be given more latitude to identify their own priorities and develop appropriate plans. Kim reminded people to review the Maintenance Guide manual. Manuals are available digitally. Kim will make sure the links are on the OWSC website.

Kim asked that the February meeting agenda include a discussion of the annual report preparation timeline.
